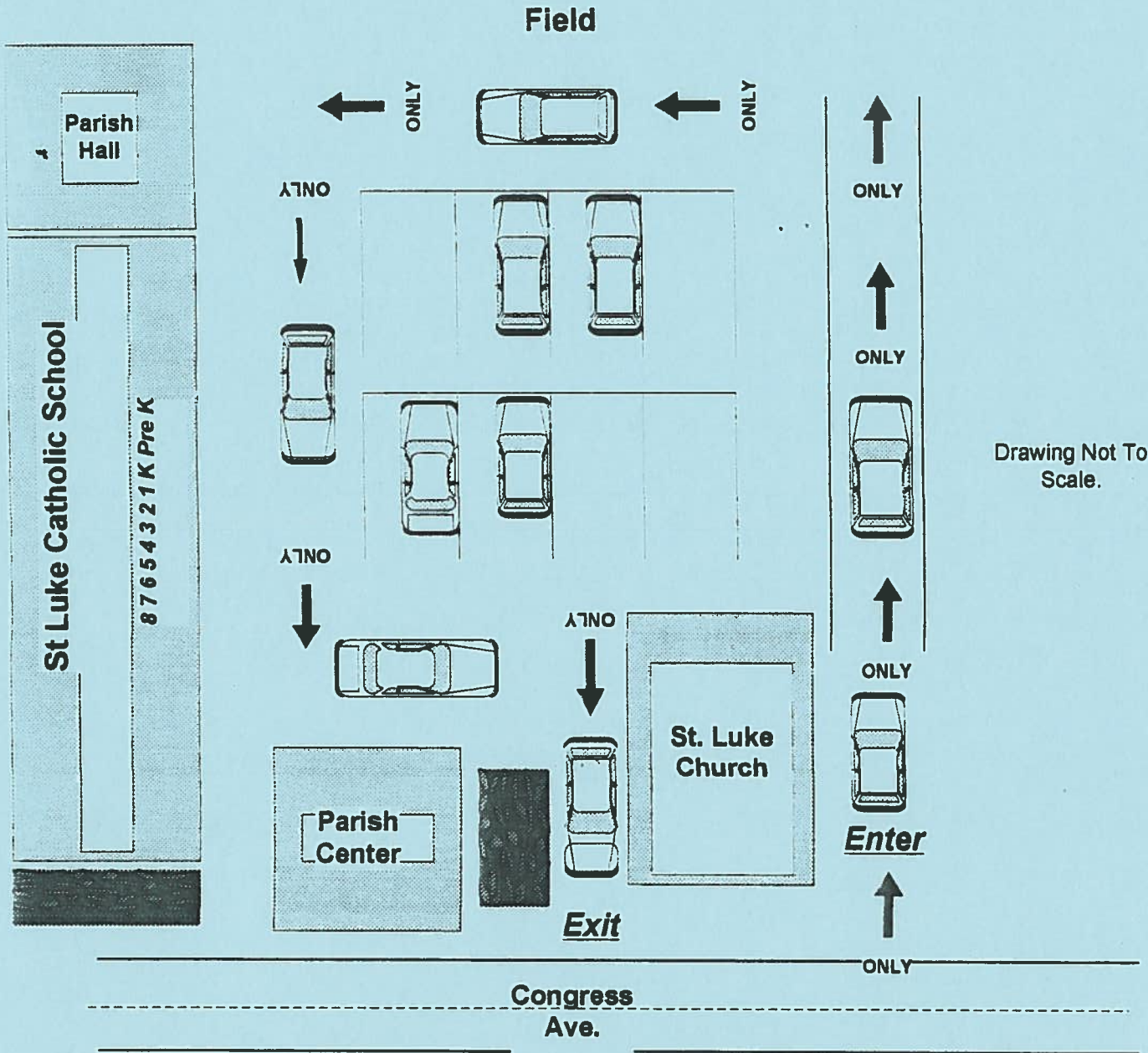
Headmaster

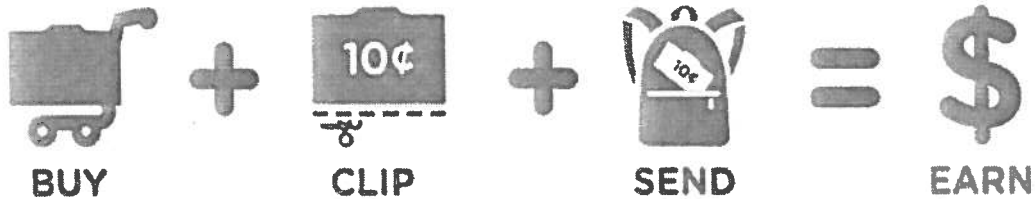

Dear Parents:

Along with the many fundraising opportunities here at St. Luke, we wanted to make sure everyone is also aware of the ways you can raise money for our school with items you may already have in your pantry or regular shopping routines:

Box Tops for Education: simply clip box tops from the product and turn them in. Since the box tops expire, it is best if you can send them in as frequently as possible. There are always special sweepstakes and promotional offers (including eBoxTops). Check out all of the ways to collect regularly at boxtops4education.com . Link your **Winn Dixie** card today and help us earn even more! Enclosed is a collection sheet or you can send the box tops in bags or envelopes.



Toner / Cartridge Recycling: simply send in your empty ink or toner cartridges. This program allows the school to recycle ink or toner cartridges for cash or supplies.

Shoparoo (shoparoo.com): download the app, Snap pictures of your receipts from any store, big or small, that sells grocery items to earn Roo Points (cash donations) for your school. It doesn't matter where you shop or what items you buy - Shoparoo will make a cash donation for every receipt! Submit up to 20 grocery receipts within a rolling 7 day period. Here are some examples of retailers (hurry, we have until 8/31/16 to earn \$50 that will count towards last school year – that means we can earn even more for this coming year).

Grocery Stores – Convenience – Supercenters - Club Stores - Drug Stores - Liquor Stores - Dollar Stores – Restaurants – Hardware – Department – Electronics - Sports stores - Office supply Bookstores – Cafes - Arts & Crafts



Labels for education: The program will be wrapping up its last year during the 2016-17 school year. Please send in all of your labels for education as soon as possible. They run special promos / bonus offers during certain months so the more frequently these are submitted the better.
